Sometimes terrible things lead to wonderful innovation, eg a cholera outbreak in London in the 1850's was followed by the building of an extensive underground sewer system which improved the lives of everyone in the city for many years afterwards. Let's allow God to inspire us through our lockdown experiences to be brave, think creatively and "boldly go" to faithfully serve Him wherever He leads.

We're all looking forward to being able to meet physically for worship. Although we don't yet know when that will be, the time is getting nearer. We've heard that the Chinese symbol for "crisis" is a combination of the symbols for "danger" and "opportunity"; this may be a once-in-a-lifetime opportunity to reassess our priorities. What have we really missed over the past few months? Is there anything we've found we've actually been quite happy not to be doing? Have we found different ways to engage with others? Have we learnt anything during lockdown that we should take forward? Most importantly, as God's people, what will sharing His love, here in Fullarton and Harbourside and beyond, look like from now on? Even if it were possible to go back to our old and comfortable ways, which is unlikely for the foreseeable future, is God prompting us to try something a little different as a church or in ConneXions?

Maybe some ideas have crossed your mind and you've thought, "No, that's

ridiculous...” But maybe similar ideas have been planted in other folks’ minds too. Let’s share our daft – and not so daft – ideas as we seek to discern what God is saying to us!
