**BLYTHSWOOD CARE - UKRAINE CRISIS APPEAL.** The Blythswood Care Ukraine Crisis Appeal has (at Tuesday 15<sup>th</sup>) reached over **£260k** – and still increasing!

Blythswood Care is sending finance to long-standing partner charity organisations in Kyiv - Ukraine; Chisinau - Moldova; Sliven – Bulgaria, and 7 others in Romania.

Blythswood Care is also trying to send 4 fire appliances to Ukraine this week, working with their partners, the Scottish Emergency Rescue Association.

The generosity shown by organisations and individuals is extraordinary. It ranges from large business cheques to a lady who gave her weekly pension and another who had to give up driving, sold her car and donated the proceeds to the Appeal.
