Ukraine Emergency Appeal (UEA) – update 3

(Blythswood Care's involvement via its network of Partners)

Appeal income received up to end of March is over

HALF a MILLION pounds - with more coming in daily.

Here are updates on some of the partner organisations

Asociatia Pro Charis (Florentin Clipa) Suceava – Romania

Florentin is looking at long term care for refugees. Since mid-March, he has been going into the Ukraine with larger amounts of food-aid.

Popesti Baptists (Pastor Dan Micula) Marghita – Romania

Since mid-March Marghita and Popesti Church have prepared food packages which they take to a Church in the Ukraine who distribute it as far away as Kyiv for people currently living underground because of the bombing.

Good News Foundation (Lilla Ficsor) Orgvany – Hungary

Lilla and her team are housing refugees coming into Hungary from the Ukraine. At present they have 5-6 families with them each day.

Baptist Church (Charlie Nicholson) Nisporeni - Moldova

This group are currently using the Children's Home and Friendship Flat for refugees.
