### Ukraine Emergency Appeal (UEA) – update 4 – 13 April 22

Blythswood Care's Involvement Through its Network of Partners

This is the latest update from Blythswood Care's headquarters in Deephaven.

The income received up to the end of last week is almost **£600,000** - with more coming in daily.

Blythswood Care is still working with the same partner organisations in Romania, sending regular amounts of money (£25-£30k to each) to ensure a fair and sensible distribution.

The 4 refurbished and re-equipped Fire appliances sent to Ukraine have arrived safely and are operational. (See Blythswood Care's Facebook page)
