**Book to come away for two nights** with others from United Irvine Church of Scotland. You can enjoy good food, in lovely surroundings, join in activities for all ages, explore the Bible in different ways, go for walks, relax and "hang out" together, living like one big family for a couple of days.

### Weekend Away 1 Gowanbank SU Centre, Darvel, 6<sup>th</sup>–8<sup>th</sup> September 2024.

Rooms are mostly single sex dormitories and some family rooms. Cost is £85 per person (includes all meals). Subsidies available for unwaged and larger families; just pay a £10 deposit in March 2024 and save at least £5 each month. To Book put a £10 deposit into an envelope marked, "FAO Sandy Dickson, September Weekend Away" add your name and contact details then put it into Sunday morning collection plate, or email Sheena.

**If you hope to attend the Gowanbank weekend** (6<sup>th</sup> – 8<sup>th</sup> September) but have not yet paid a deposit, please do so as soon as possible. Remember that subsidies will only be available to those who have been paying in at least £5 per month - but if you have not yet made a payment for April, it's not too late!

### Weekend Away 2 - Field Studies Centre, Millport, 7<sup>th</sup>–9<sup>th</sup> Feb. 2025.

Rooms are mostly en-suite twin beds.

Cost is approximately £85 per person \*\* (includes all meals). Subsidies and saving scheme available as above. Booking: As with Gowanbank but mark envelope with "February Weekend Away"

*\*\*Cost depends on final number attending to be confirmed by November 2024.*

You can also book as a Day Visitors on each Saturday. Just £5 per meal for lunch and/or dinner.
